Dear Colleague,

Welcome to the 2025 Unite Education Programme for the South East Region.

This course programme outlines the wide range of courses available to you as a Unite activist in the South East. In today's world of work, it can be challenging being a representative. Our Education programme is designed to make sure you have the skills to support and empower our members in their day to day working lives and fight for decent Jobs, Pay and Conditions. Our workplace rep's courses and health and safety courses are all accredited by Ruskin College Oxford.

All our courses are delivered using either online virtual Google Classroom platform or face to face in a Unite Office. Offering both these platforms of learning has been a great success in how we have delivered our training to the South East regional representatives and an important part of our training model. The courses are arranged into four blocks each with five days in each block and run throughout the year at various locations in the region.

Another addition to the core training are webinars that are available to both reps and Unite Members. Detail of the types of workshops we plan to run are in the brochure. Regular mail outs will be sent out periodically with details on times and dates.

Any courses that don't recruit sufficiently will be merged and converted to a course running on Google Classroom.

As well as gaining knowledge, everyone on the course is encouraged to share their experiences and develop problem solving skills that they can take back to assist them in their efforts in the workplace. In addition to the courses outlined in this brochure we can also offer short courses tailored to the needs of individual workplaces or activists. We are also keen to develop new courses to reflect specific strategic, industrial or political goals. 



- Understand the key points of new equalities legislation, measures and legal decisions
- Decide how best to support workers in response to new equalities legislation
- Use interviewing techniques to deal with individual and workplace equality issues
- Develop equality policies and practice

- Involving the members in Health and Safety
- Accident Investigations Risk Assessments

If you are unsure whether you will benefit from attending these courses, please discuss this with your Regional Education Officer for advice as to whether to apply for such training. Please note that the course numbers are limited and the National Education Department will confirm your place, travel and accommodation eight weeks before the course takes place. Unite is committed to making reasonable adjustments to ensure equal access to education courses for members with disabilities. Please complete the form setting out your disability access requirements and submit to the National Education Department with your application form. This programme includes our national equality leadership courses which are designed as a positive action measure to develop the leadership skills and provide a voice for underrepresented workers in our Union. Please take note of the eligibility requirements to attend these courses. Our National Women's Week is for Women members, and our National Black and Asian Reps Leadership Development course is for Black and Asian reps only.
