We want support for older people who want to use digital technologies. We campaign to get Government, Health, Local Government, Banks, Buses, Trains, and other services to ensure that those who do not wish to do so or cannot do so are not disadvantaged or discriminated against.

The Older People's Commissioner for Wales says that Digital exclusion is creating new barriers for older people.

Older People's Commissioner for Wales, Heléna Herklots CBE issued statutory guidance in 2021 which set out the kinds of action local authorities and health boards should be taking to ensure that people's rights to access information and services via non-digital means are upheld.

The Commissioner has said:

"To better understand the particular issues people are facing, and the impact these are having on people's lives, I'm keen for older people who are not online or who struggle using digital technology to contact my office to highlight any difficulties and barriers they have faced."

Public Transport Railway Ticket Offices

NPC Wales is supporting the RMT campaign against the proposed closure of the majority of ticket offices (1,000 of them) in England.

NPC Wales wrote to Lee Waters MS the Deputy Minister for Climate change whose responsibilities include Public Transport. Trafnidiaeth Cymru/Transport for Wales manages all 223 Railway stations in Wales.

• We hope that there are no plans to close our ticket offices in Wales.

We got a positive reply:

"I understand your concerns and frustration regarding the closure of ticket offices in England. Transport for Wales (TfW) are not part of this announcement, and they have **no plans** to close ticket offices at their stations in Wales or those they operate in England."

Buses in Wales



In May Lee Waters MS Deputy
Minister for Climate Change made an
oral statement, in the Senedd,
confirming that funding had been
found to keep most bus services
running in Wales for this financial
year.

In June the First Minister, Mark
Drakeford announced Welsh
Government's legislative programme
for the next year. It includes:
One network, one timetable, one
ticket: planning buses as a public
service for Wales

The Bus Bill is meant to reform and improve bus services, putting people before profit, to match what our communities need.

This new law will give local authorities better tools to plan and deliver bus services.


NPC Wales will be watching with interest!

Our current key campaigns are for:


- The recovery of the NHS in Wales and the development of a fully integrated Social Care service, free at the point of need, as its first priority.
