Welcome to the 2025/2026 Unite Wales Education brochure

Unite is a trade union dedicated to improving the pay and conditions of its members. Our reps education programme supports this through the delivery of training that equips our reps with the skills and confidence to be strong and effective in the workplace. Building workplace power is how we hold employers to account and win for our members.

Unite training is delivered by tutors who have all been at the sharp end themselves, representing Unite members in their own workplaces. Courses are delivered in a friendly and informal way, enabling reps to build relationships and contacts with activists from other workplaces and sectors. Unite education is delivered in a variety of ways, primarily in person at our Unite offices across Wales. We also offer our workplace reps the ability to complete their training online through Zoom. Reps have the ability to mix and match how they attend our courses, ensuring that whatever part of Wales they are from, they are able to access the training they need.

For Workplace Reps and Health and Safety Reps we provide a clear 20 day training pathway, with courses split into 4 modules. All our courses require reps to secure paid release from their employer and are delivered during the week from 9.30am – 4.00pm. Your full time officer can help you to secure paid release if you experience difficulties.

This year we will be running new refresher training for both workplace reps and health and safety reps, who may have completed all of the introductory training Unite offers. These courses titled "Advanced Reps Refresher Training"

will be available in both our offices and online. We have also introduced a new Accident Investigation course.

In addition to the fantastic courses for our Workplace Reps, Health and Safety, Equality and Learning Reps, we can also run bespoke courses and bite size training upon request. Unite education is very flexible and if our advertised courses don't suit your working patterns please get in touch. We are usually able to provide training designed to meet the specific needs of your workplace.

All of our courses are delivered in partnership with Adult Learning Wales. If you sign up to one of our online courses please be reassured that participation is very simple and you will receive pre-course help to familiarise yourself with online learning. The only technology you require to participate is a tablet or computer.
