CUTS TO 'LOW LEVEL' CARE IS A FALSE ECONOMY

Jon French, Information Officer at Cardiff Council,

"I've worked in adult social care for 22 years and you can see the effect of cuts across the board in terms of care. We provide less services than we used to, respite care and day centres are now gone – people now only get care if they are seriously ill.....This ends up costing more in the long term, as 'low-level' care was preventative"



'WE ARE WAY PAST EFFICIENCY SAVINGS NOW'

Carol Starr, Home Care Worker in Nottingham,

"I worked for the council for 30 years before I was made redundant last September. As a care worker I never expected to be made redundant because we were always short-staffed and busy, but my situation was directly a result of council cuts..... "We are way past efficiency savings now and seeing direct cuts to public services, walking around Nottingham you can see the neglect."
