Our Education programme is designed to make sure you have the skills to support and empower our members in their day to day working lives and fight for decent Jobs, Pay and Conditions.

As a Unite activist you are the union's most precious resource. Now, more than ever, Unite members need well trained and informed representatives to improve their working conditions. Key to this is supporting our activists with high quality education.

For Workplace Reps and Health and Safety Reps we provide a clear 20-day training pathway for each discipline, with courses split into 4 stages, with each module running for one week. You will require paid release and courses will be delivered during the week from 09.30am – 16.30pm in the classroom or online. Paid facility time should be available from your employer to attend the course, should you have any difficulties, contact the office where we can make this application on your behalf.

In addition to the fantastic courses for our Workplace Reps, Health and Safety and Equality Reps, we also run additional and bespoke courses and bite size training upon request. Unite education is flexible and we are able to provide training designed to meet the specific needs of your workplace. - Understand the key points of new equalities legislation, measures and legal decisions
- Decide how best to support workers in response to new equalities legislation
- Use interviewing techniques to deal with individual and workplace equality issues
- Develop equality policies and practices.

NEW COURSE

We will look at what each of these conditions is and the terminology that is associated with neurodiverse conditions. We will learn about the experiences of someone with neurodiverse conditions and develop a better appreciation of the challenges that can be faced by neurodivergent individuals.

We will also explore steps that can be taken to make interactions and environments more accommodating for those with neurodiverse conditions and how we can campaign and organise in the workplace to support all.

Environment Reps

NEW COURSES

Duration: Variable

Environment Reps:

Unite are at the forefront of the trade Union response to climate change. This course covers the nature of the climate crisis, how we as reps can begin to change our workplaces and environments for the better through shortening supply chains, activism and realistic change.

Extreme Temperatures and Weather:

This course focuses on the working environment, particularly those working outdoors or where there is limited control of workplace temperatures. We look at how extreme temperatures affect workplaces, current legislation and why unions are calling for changes to the law. We then move on to the impact changing weather has on our day-today activity, covering health and working conditions.

- Understanding the 'Strategy for Growth' and the crucial role that the branch plays
- Setting out a local 'strategy for growth' for recruitment, retention and participation in branch life
- Chairing and Organising Skills

NEW COURSES

Duration: 5 consecutive days

Redundancy and TUPE:

Redundancy and TUPE covers the basics of the contract of employment, TUPE and redundancy legislation

Mental Health Awareness:

This course is designed to introduce the topics of stress, anxiety and mental health from a trade union perspective. It will assist reps in promoting wellbeing in the workplace and to understand the issues faced by members at work. You will develop a better understanding of the Equality Act 2010 and how it applies to people with mental health illnesses. The training will enable you to develop a strategy to deal with mental health and wellbeing issues in the workplace, and ensure employees are not discriminated against.

Effective Communications:

This course covers a variety of communication methods and how we can use them. We cover:

- How to use social media and social media case law
- Creating newsletters with basic IT
- Public Speaking and dealing with the media
- Creating effective posters and flyers
- Combatting fake news and organising online

Additional Courses

Duration: Variable

Stress Management (Three consecutive days):

Looks at what the different types of stress are, how to handle stress at work, legislation covering mental health and strategies for improving mental ill health. We also look at how to support ourselves as reps and our members.

Cancer Awareness (One day):

This short course looks at:

- What the key messages are around cancer awareness
- How to address the fears and barriers faced by people when talking about cancer, how to have effective, conversations about cancer and health
- Legislation to protect workers and improving workplace policies

Challenging Conversations (Three consecutive days):

This course covers good practice on how to handle the difficult conversations that might be faced in your role as a rep and activist. We will look at case studies, questioning techniques and unacceptable behaviours in the workplace, building your confidence as we progress through the course. We also consider the impact our behaviours and language used in broader society, focusing on how to engage constructively in broader debate and how to support mental ill health.

Duration: One Day

Domestic Abuse Awareness:

This short course focuses on:

- How to develop a domestic abuse policy at work
- What support and signposting is available
- How to support members and reps at work The course covers sensitive issues and will be delivered in a safe environment.

Menopause Awareness:

The impact of menopause on women is often an issue not discussed in the workplace. We look at gaining a better understanding of the symptoms of the menopause, key legislation, methods of campaigning and confidence in raising the issue at work.

Unconscious Bias:

This course looks at what Unconscious bias is and how it can result in discrimination in the workplace. Unconscious bias influences decisions in recruitment, promotion and performance management and is something that is present in all of us.

Unite is committed to making reasonable adjustments to ensure equal access to education courses for members with disabilities. Please complete the form setting out your disability access requirements and submit to the National Education Department with your application form.

This programme includes our national equality leadership courses which are designed as a positive action measure to develop the leadership skills and provide a voice for underrepresented workers in our Union. Please take note of the eligibility requirements to attend these courses. Our National Women's Week is for Women members, and our National Black and Asian Reps Leadership Development course is for Black and Asian reps only. National residential courses will begin at 15:00 hrs on Monday and finish with a session on Action Plans at noon on the Friday. You will appreciate that being residential students are expected to participate in a couple of evening sessions which are less formal.
